Florida Local Government Information Systems Association Use of FLGISA Name or Logo Policy

Prohibitions

The FLGISA will not allow its name or logo to be used to endorse, promote, and represent a partnership or business relationship for any product or service without the express consent of the Board of Directors.

Acceptable Use

The FLGISA may allow the name and/or logo to be used by other associations, organizations, and companies as an endorsement of a specific program if pre-approved by the Board of Directors. An example of this type of endorsement would be the Certified Public Technology Leadership (CPTL) program in which FLGISA has partnered with the John Scott Dailey Florida Institute of Government.

The Association President or Executive Director may grant the use of FLGISA name and logo to:

- FLGISA event speakers for use in their presentations and materials
- FLGISA members for speaking engagements where appropriate
- Other situations deemed appropriate that do not violate the above-stated prohibitions
